Frequent Questions:

Do I have to type the Essays or Recommendation Letter?

No. The essays and recommendation letters can be handwritten. The handwriting must be clear and legible. All essays and materials are judged the same whether or not they are typed or handwritten.

I don't have any school, community or household leadership, can I still apply?

Yes. School, community or household leadership is not required.

I am unable to get a teacher to write a recommendation letter, can I still apply?

Yes. A recommendation letter from a teacher is not required. You will be considered for a scholarship if you meet the required criteria.

SCHOLARSHIP RETENTION REQUIREMENTS

CEF Scholars who are awarded scholarships must meet the following requirements to ensure s/he will maintain the scholarship each year.

1. Daily School Attendance
2. Good Grades: at least "B" Average
3. Good Character

Scholars who fail to maintain the above requirements will not receive renewal of the scholarship.

Certification

I understand and acknowledge that I must be enrolled full time and in good standing in school in the Caribbean during 2007-2008 in order to be eligible for and receive the award. I have read and understand all of the terms and conditions of the CEF Scholarship.
